

At Sixteenth Street Community Health Centers (SSCHC) we want to ensure everyone we serve can have affordable access to their life saving medicines. If you cannot afford your medicine, please let us know and we will do everything possible to help you. Our ability to access the federal 340B drug pricing program is a key tool we use to ensure this is possible.

What is 340B?

340B is a government medication pricing program that helps Sixteenth Street care for underserved and uninsured patients in our community. The Sixteenth Street Sliding Fee Program is Sixteenth Street's discount medication program and is supported by our participation in 340B.

What are the benefits of using a SSCHC partner pharmacy?

- 1) Patients who cannot afford their medicine may be eligible to receive a discount at one of our partner pharmacies.
- 2) The leadership teams from our partner pharmacies meet regularly with us here at SSCHC to ensure they are meeting our expectations for excellent customer service. At these meetings, we also discuss new ways for the pharmacy to work better with SSCHC so our patients get the best possible care.
- 3) Several of our partner pharmacies can communicate with your provider and care team in real-time via an instant messaging system so refill requests, medication prior authorizations, and clinical questions can be handled quicker than at other pharmacies.
- 4) Sixteenth Street and your community benefits when you fill medicine at a partner pharmacy, because we generate medication savings that can be used to:
 - Care for underserved patients who, otherwise, would not have access to health care
 - Support current patient programs and create new ones to better serve our community
 - Hire additional providers, nurses, and support staff with expertise to ensure our patients receive the best possible care
 - Maintain and grow our facilities to better serve our patients and community
